December Vestry Highlights

At the December Vestry meeting, the Vestry:

- Discussed ways to engage the Parish during Advent & Christmas.
- Heard that the Episcopal Church will postpone its 80th General Convention until July 2022.
- Heard that our Advent Program (Ravi Zacharias, Jesus among other gods) is going well.
- Decided to cancel the Annual Vestry Christmas party.
- Heard that Christmas fruitcakes/fudge have been sent to St. Paul's staff.
- Heard that Vestry background checks continue.
- Agreed unanimously with the Sr. Warden that we appreciate the excellent work of the Tech Team.
- Heard the St. Joseph's Guild continues to be on virus hiatus, but the repair/maintenance work is still being completed.
- Heard details on an alternate bid (a metal roof) for the Parish Hall roof.
- Heard that the Vestry will provide Christmas hams (or turkeys) for the St. Paul's School staff/teachers.
- Heard that, all things considered, St. Paul's School is doing OK, and had no COVID-19 infections in November.
- Decided to have the annual Vestry retreat and February Vestry meeting on Saturday February 13th in Clardy Hall from 8:30 noon.
- Decided that the Annual Parish meeting on January 31st will be held immediately after the Sunday service. The meeting will be in-person, and via Zoom, with voting available for both. Following the meeting, we'll have lunch provided by a single source rather than potluck.
- Heard that Stewardship is going slower than desired, but OK. The roof fund stands at \$40K.
- Approved the Bylaws revision to have a Special Vestry meeting following the Annual meeting to appoint additional members, if desired.
- Approved the Rector's housing allowance for 2021.
- Heard that November income was \$13,094.15, and expense was \$14,864.68, thus we had a loss of \$1,770.53.
