- **Valentine's Day** This year Valentine's Day falls on a Sunday, and the Last Sunday of the Epiphany. It also will be the Sunday that we're permitted by the Diocese to have greater capacity in the church building. Therefore, we happily have no need to have our overflow in Clardy Hall. Come on back to in-person church in the church building!
- **Lent is Coming!** Lent starts on Ash Wednesday (February 17th). We'll have the Imposition of Ashes and Holy Eucharist at noon and 6 pm. There will be no Shrove Tuesday service or Pancake dinner this year.
- Lenten Program Our Lenten program for 2021 will be Christian: It's not what you think. The program will begin the first Thursday of Lent (the 18th), and continue through all the Thursdays of March. We started this program in 2020, but COVID-19 rudely shut us down. As in year's past, our program will be in Clardy Hall on Thursday nights, starting with dinner at 6:00 pm, the program at 6:30, and small group discussion until 7:30.
