### Announcements

- Lenten Program Our Lenten program for 2021 will be Christian: It's not what you think. The program will begin the first Thursday of Lent (the 18th), and continue through all the Thursdays of March. We started this program in 2020, but COVID-19 rudely shut us down. - **Stations of the Cross** We're going to have an outdoor Stations of the Cross! We're in the process of manufacturing 14 Stations of the Cross that will be open for prayer 24/7, and especially at 6:00 pm on the Fridays in Lent.
- **Episcopal Diocese of Dallas podcasts** The EDOD is offering a daily podcast from the clergy of the Episcopal Diocese of Dallas offers a reflection on scripture from the Old Testament Reading of the Daily Office Morning Prayer.
