## *June Vestry Highlights*

### **At the June Vestry meeting, the Vestry:**

- Discussed Kevin Martin's *Parish Leadership Guide for the New Normal* and discerning a parish's purpose/mission.
- Decided to have the Vestry meet on the first Tuesday at 6:00 for dinner and Bible study, and add 6:00 dinner to the regular 3rd Tuesday meeting. This will go on for the next three months.
- Approved that the proceeds of the July Rummage sale be divided equally between the Women of St. Paul's and St. Joseph's Guild for use with local needs.
- Decided to sponsor a Potluck on August 29th.
- Allowed Greenville Christian School to use our back field as a part of their Cross Country training area.
- Heard that the Trauma Team is up and running.
- Heard that regular cleaning and maintenance continues to occur, and that we have no leaks in the roof.
- Heard that our new School Director, Julie Hensley, has started work.
- Approved the use of Clardy Hall during the summer by school age children under supervision of the school.
- Approved the motion by the Columbarium Committee to repaint and add framed screens to the Bell Tower, as well as drilling a hole for drainage.
- Heard that the May income was \$14,286 and expenses were \$20,367, thus we had a negative cash flow of \$6,080.
