Cover Art: This coin, minted in 56-57 AD, bears the portrait of Salome, daughter of Herodias, the infamous wife of Herod Antipas. Only three copies of this coin have been published to date. The coin depicts the Herodian King of Armenia, Aristobulus and Salome, 54-72 AD, struck 66/67 AD under Nero, bronze 8.90 grams Obverse: Aristobulus left "of King Aristobulus, year 13". Reverse: Salome left "of Queen Salome."
