At the July Vestry meeting, the Vestry:

- Discussed Kevin Martin's Parish Leadership Guide for the New Normal and ways to engage our online viewers.
- Heard that Mike Lavigne and John-Paul Ballard have resigned from the Vestry
- Heard that after more than a year of inactivity, the Circle of Care has disbanded, and the women's groups of St. Paul's will consider aiding in pastoral care needs.
- Heard that the Rummage Sale was a success, and raised about \$2,700.
- Heard that St. Paul's has reserved the Hunt County Paintball field for August 28th at 10:00 am. Members and friends will be welcome.
- Heard that the Vestry will sponsor a Parish Potluck on August 29th.
- · Heard that the parking lot has been repaired.
- Heard that at the request of the Clean Team, the Junior Warden is soliciting bids for cleaning.
- Heard that Sam Asseff and Jacob Faunce are doing the mowing.
- Heard that the Outreach Committee will produce a brochure highlighting our ongoing outreach ministries: St. Paul's Episcopal School, Fruitful Ministries, and For the City.
- Heard that the Outreach Committee will have a weekly column featuring needs of our school.
- Heard that the June income was \$12,536 and expenses were \$14,750 thus we had a negative cash flow of \$2,214.
