# Morsel for Meditation

First, true religion consists of righteousness. We cannot doubt this fact if we remember the words of our Lord describing the two grand branches of righteousness. On these hang all the law and the prophets. "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment," the first and great branch of Christian righteousness. You shall delight yourself in the Lord your God, and you will seek and find all happiness in him. In time and eternity, the Lord will be "your shield, and your reward shall be very great." Your entire frame will cry out, "Whom have I in heaven but you? And there is nothing on earth that I desire other than you." Then you will hear and fulfill the word of God who says, "My Child, give me your heart." And, having given him your heart, your inmost self, in which he reigns without a rival, you may well cry out in the fullness of your soul, "The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my deliverer, my God, my rock in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold."

• Are you interested in running for a position on the Vestry? As a church, we will be select our new Vestry members at the Annual Meeting on January 30th. According to the Constitution and Canons of the Episcopal Church, Constitution and Canons of the Episcopal Diocese of Dallas, and the By-Laws of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, to be eligible to vote or hold office at St. Paul's Episcopal Church a person must meet all the following qualifications:

- Be 18 years of age or older and confirmed/received in the Episcopal Church.
- Faithfully working, praying, and giving for the Kingdom of God.
- Be a financial contributor of record for the preceding year.
- Regularly attend corporate worship, having been faithful in corporate worship in the preceding year, unless for good cause prevented from attending.
- Be a communicant in good standing, having received Holy Communion in the Parish at least three times during the preceding year.
- Be listed in the St. Paul's Parish Register, and do not claim membership in another parish/ church.
- Be able to pass a background check. (SPEC requirement)

• On Sunday, February 13th, The Rev. Samira Page will be preaching at both services and will give a presentation about her refugee ministry, Gateway of Grace, after the 10:30 service at coffee hour.
