At the April Vestry Meeting:

- Vestry was reminded by David Gish to self-examine how their spiritual development was progressing as it relates to the growth the church.
- David Gish gave kudos to all who involved in making the Easter service both beautiful and inspirational.
- David reminded the newcomers to the vestry that they must complete the safeguard training
- Heard there could be a social event that would celebration in honor of a project being completed
- Heard that thee 18 people that participated in the all-church clean up on 4/9
- Heard that the vestry accepted a bid for a to remove the existing ceiling in the parish hall then replace it with a brand-new ceiling after we replace the broken unit
- Debbie Schaffer reported that our St. pals school received a grant for over \$330,000
- School presents a plan to have extra students in a summer program
- Heard that vestry approved a request for a/v equipment for \$5,436 and \$149.25 for cost of cinctures
