Vestry Highlights - April 16

- Heard that Bishop Sumner will come for his official visit on October 20th. Confirmation classes will be announced in the near future.
- Heard that Bishop Sumner will visit the Diocese of Kinkizi (in southwest Uganda) to explore Companion Diocese relationship.
- Heard that the participants of the Lenten Series, Christianity Explored, rated the experience highly.
- Heard that a point strongly made at Clergy Conference: 'If the members of the parish do not see themselves as evangelists for the parish, the parish won't grow.'
- Heard that May will be Mission Month. This includes
 - National Day of Prayer at noon on the Courthouse steps in Greenville.
 - May 4th is Mission Day for the Diocese (at St. Luke's in Dallas)
 - May 18th from 9:30 am - 1pm, St. Paul's will have an Evangelism Workshop with Cn. Carrie Headington (lunch provided)
 - New information brochures are being produced.
- Decided to have a picnic theme for the June 5th Sunday Vestry supper following the 10:30 service.
- Heard that we'll have a Parish Cleanup on April 20th and paint the Sacristies from April 22-24. While the Sacristies are being painted, the church will be locked at night.
- Heard that the Board President (Ashley Cotton) will step down in April, Vice President (Elizabeth Porter) will step up. Ashley remains on the Board.
- Decided that the excess proceeds from the Shrove Tuesday breakfast will go to St. Joseph's Guild budget items.
